
BASTING STITCH

Basting stitch is used to temporarily join two pieces of fabric and to keep necklines, armholes from stretching during the garment construction. It's like a loose running stitch.

Our nuno-felted garments have raw edges at the neckline, armholes and the front panels. This fabric is somewhat stretchy therefore it is very important to temporarily secure those areas of the garment with basting stitch while working on the embroidery and assemble the garment.

Use a single strand all purpose sewing thread with loose knots at the beginning and the end of work.



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
